Headteacher's message

Larry Kingsley

I am very sad to share with you that Larry Kingsley passed away on 26th October 2024. Larry Kingsley had a dream for many years to see a Jewish primary school south of the river in London. Before 2010, there was no available route to establishing a school accessible to all and funded by the government!

The Conservative-Liberal Democrat coalition introduced free schools following the 2010 general election as part of the Big Society initiative. Free schools were an extension of the academy programme, and parents, teachers, charities and business could set up their own schools if they navigated the extremely demanding and competitive, application process.

Larry's contribution was bringing together a group of people from across the Jewish and wider communities. He started the process of research and consultation which resulted in a Steering Group being formed with people who had the knowledge, skills and experience to put together a successful application to the Department for Education.

He followed this process from the sidelines keenly and was delighted to see Mosaic open in 2013. We extend our condolences to all his family and friends.

Today we came together as a school for our annual Remembrance day walk to the Putney Cenotaph. Each year, we remember the people and animals from across all communities who have fought for our freedom.
